The Institute is part of a network of organisations such as OECD (PUMA and SIGMA), Transparency International, government agencies such as the US Office of Government Ethics, various anti-corruption commissions, international organisations of ombudsmen, internal auditors, auditors-general, inspectors-general, and university-based specialist research units working in relevant areas, such as applied ethics, social science law, law, government and public administration.
